
In Oslo the secretary of EuSEN, Ole-Petter Vinjevoll organized a very interesting visit to the Emergency Department of the Ullevål Hospital.

Emergency department nurses' impact on patient safety

- Background

Emergency departments (ED) in the western world experience increased amount of health care seeking patients since several decades. Regardless of reason for the increasing amount of patients seeking ED care, the result on the ED is the same, crowding. Crowding results negatively on both individual (patients and clinicians), organizational (the ED and hospital) and societal levels. From the individual perspective, ED length of stay (LoS) increases which results in patients spending more time waiting for various actions (e.g. to see a physician or to be discharged or admitted) but also decreased patient safety as adverse events increase. However, the relationship between prolonged LoS and adverse events is not fully understood.

- Aim

The overall aim of this research project is to investigate ED nurses' impact on ED patient safety.

The project led by associate professor Katarina Göransson at the Karolinska University Hospital Solna in Sweden. Collaboration is ongoing with other nurse researchers in Sweden and we are inviting nurse researchers in other European countries to collaborate with us in this study.

Australian emergency nurses are integral to decision making with ventilator settings and share responsibility for ongoing care of the mechanically ventilated patient with their medical colleagues. You are uniquely placed to inform research around ventilation practices in Australian ED's; of which there is a desperate need for further enquiry.




